Hi Adrienne and Andy,

It looks like a temporary power pole was issued to the property at the end of the street. This property was assigned a temporary address (214 St. Pauls) by the Planning Department. The permit was issued to a customer that was claiming to be the property owner; however, they have since been determined not to be. The permit was issued on 11/30/2017, likely on misrepresented facts. Since the person pulling the permit was not authorized, and therefore the permit not valid, Dominion has been contacted and is expected to remove the temporary pole.

Hi Julie,

Thanks for taking some to chat with me about the story Andy's working on. It is about a group of "squatters" who have built a shack on the back end of 1309 Virginia Beach Boulevard. The property owner is trying to get the "squatters" off his property, but he's having to go through court.

The shack apparently has power. Andy has talked with Bonita at Dominion. She says they got power legally, and she believes it was to 214 St. Paul's Street address.

I put in a FOIA request for existing power permits for the following addresses in Virginia Beach:

1309 Virginia Beach Boulevard  
214 St. Paul's Street  
214 St. Paul's Place

Given Andy's deadline, we were hoping someone from your office could do a quick scan to pull the power permits for these three addresses. My guess is that there will only be permits for 1309 Virginia Beach Boulevard, because that is the only legal address. The two St. Paul's addresses don't exist, according to Google Earth, Accurint, and the city's website.
