What Happened

Details

Hi my name is Linda Jackson, There are a series of events that has happened to me over the last few months that has devastated my life. In July 2012, I went to see Dr. Javid Perwaiz because I was having lower abdominal pain and

pain in my pelvic area. He examined me then he set me up for an ultrasound the following week. He prescribed me an antibiotic because he said that I had an infection. I went back on 8/1/12 for an ultrasound, then Dr. Perwaiz called me into his office to discuss the results. He told me that I have a large cyst/heterogenous mass adjacent to my left ovary. He said that I needed to have surgery to remove my left ovary and the cyst. I had surgery on 8/11/12 at Chesapeake General Hospital by Dr. Jarvald Perwaiz. I have a copy of his surgery notes and office notes stating that he had removed my left ovary and a portion of my left fallopian tube. After the surgery I've been back to see Dr. Perwaiz about 3 times because I was in a lot of pain. The first time that I went I was bleeding from the incision, he said that I had a pocket of blood under the incision and gave me an antibiotic and sent me home. He said that the incision was taking longer to heal because my stomach was hanging over it, that really hurt my feelings. Then I went back to see him again because I was still in a lot of pain, when he examined me he said that I had a knot growing around my vulvar area that need to be removed ASAP, so he performed surgery and removed it on 10/20/12. He said that the results of the biopsy showed that the cyst had a lot of bacteria growing in it, so he prescribed me another antibiotic. I went back to see him again a week later on 10/24/12 for another ultrasound which he said showed that medial to my right ovary, my right fallopian tube had a hydrosalpinx (blocked fallopian tube filled with fluid) and was infected with bacteria, he prescribed me another antibiotic. I started crying because I was scared and devastated about having surgery again. Dr. Perwaiz scheduled me to come back for another ultrasound in 2 weeks. I went back on 11/5/12 for another ultrasound, now he says that my left fallopian tube has a heterogenous mass on it and the hydrosalpinx on the right side has doubled in size since I was last seen. Now he wants to operate again to remove my right fallopian tube and the mass located where my left ovary was removed from. I asked him where did the mass come from, especially so soon after removing my left ovary from that same area. He told me that he wasn't sure. I also asked him about the reoccurring infections and he said that he wasn't sure why I was having reoccurring infections. He couldn't really give me a straight answer to any of my questions, so I decided to get a second opinion. I went to see [redacted], she examined me and requested information from Dr. Perwaiz to review. She put me on antibiotics again for a bacteria infection. She referred me to see [redacted] examined me and told me that I needed to have surgery to remove the mass and right ovary which she believed was causing the problem. On 1/8/13 [redacted] performed surgery at Chesapeake General Hospital. On 1/8/13 I was told by one of the ER nurses that I had tested positive for MRSA back on 10/20/12. Dr Perwaiz never told me that I had MRSA. I was so scared at this point because I could have infected my family with MRSA. After [redacted] finished the surgery she came out into the waiting area to inform my family on what she had found during the surgery. She told my family that she had just removed my left ovary and left and right fallopian tube. My mother stated to her that Dr. Perwaiz had removed my left ovary in August 2012. [redacted] told my mother that she couldn't comment on what another doctor did and she stated to my family again that she had just removed my left ovary and left and right fallopian tube. My mother asked her again, just to be certain what exactly did she remove and she stated again that she had removed my left ovary and left and right fallopian tube. I requested a copy of the surgery report for 1/8/13. Dr. [redacted] stated in full detail how she identified and removed my left ovary. I went into her office a couple of weeks later for a post operative follow up visit. She asked how was I doing, I told her that I was doing ok just really sore around the incisions. Then she stated to me that during the surgery she had removed a really large leiomyoma (fibroid tumor). I told her that she had previously stated that she had removed my left ovary and I asked her why did she put in her report and tell my family that she had removed my left ovary if she was not certain. She said that the pathology report showed no residual ovarian tissue. So I went back to the hospital and requested a copy of the entire surgery report from 1/8/13. I read the pathology report which states no typical ovarian tissue identified, so I asked for a copy of the results of the actual test that was performed to identify the tissue, they didn't have anything in the report to support these findings. I now feel that [redacted] and Chesapeake General Hospital are trying to cover up for the previous doctor's mistake. I have more then one surgery report where [redacted] states that she removed my left ovary and I don't think that she would have stated this to my family or put it in her report if she wasn't sure. If she thought that she was removing an ovary I wonder if she really performed the surgery correctly since now she is stating that it wasn't an ovary. This has really been a nightmare for me. I have gone through months of being in constant pain. Even after the surgery I am still suffering from knowing that they are trying to falsify documents and cover up for there mistakes. Please help me!!!! I don't know what to do!!!! Linda Jackson
