- 1. Safely operated the largest city jail in Virginia.
- 2. Created a Reentry Program to provide inmates with the tools to improve their lives after they've completed their sentence.
- 3. Developed, funded and implemented an innovative new mental health program, resulting in a 98% success rate and efforts to expand the program statewide.
- 4. Expanded our footprint in the community, supporting important causes such as Special Olympics Virginia and appointing the office's first liaison to the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) community.
- 5. Achieved pay parity with the Virginia Beach Police Department and improved deputy training and equipment. Improved our relationship with the VBPD and provided manpower support for major events and holidays.
- 6. Ran a transparent, accountable office, working closely with the Virginia Beach Human Rights Commission and equipping the deputies with body-worn cameras.
- 7. Brought the Virginia Beach Sheriff's Office into the 21 st Century by upgrading the jail's Master Control and video visitation system, implementing real-time inmate tracking, installing an inmate body scanner to detect contraband, and more.
- 8. Reduced the burden to taxpayers of operating the jail by generating over \$4 million a year through Inmate Workforce landscaping contracts and Canteen and CareMart sales.
- 9. Created an Alternative Sentencing Program to provide creative options for nonviolent offenders to serve their debt to society, including the Weekender and Electronic Home Incarceration programs.
- 10. Recruiting and retaining a diverse workforce, becoming Virginia Values Veterans (V3) certified, and promoting the first two female chief deputies and first Filipino captain in Virginia Beach history.
