Purpose and Methodology

The City of Virgina Beach conducted a Virgina Aquarium Funding and Ownership Model Resident Survey during the fall of 2023. The purpose of the survey was to assess resident support for funding the Virgina Aquarium's needs and alternative ownership and operational models for the Virgina Aquarium.

The two-page survey, cover letter and postage paid return envelope were mailed to a random sample of households in the City of Virgina Beach. The cover letter explained the purpose of the survey and encouraged residents to either return their survey by mail or complete the survey online. At the end of the online survey, residents were asked to enter their home address, this was done to ensure that only responses from residents who were part of the random sample were included in the final survey database.

After the surveys were mailed, ETC Institute followed up with residents to encourage participation. To prevent people who were not residents of Virginia Beach from participating, everyone who completed the survey on-line was required to enter their home address prior to submitting the survey. ETC Institute then matched the addresses that were entered on-line with the addresses that were originally selected for the random sample. If the address from a survey completed on-line did not match one of the addresses selected for the sample, the on-line survey was not counted.

The goal was to obtain completed surveys from at least 500 residents. This goal was exceeded, with a total of 507 residents completing the survey. The overall results for the sample of 507 households have a precision of at least +/-4.4% at the 95% level of confidence.

Funding and Ownership of Virgina Aquarium

The survey results reveal support for the funding of the Virginia Aquarium. When asked about funding, Sixty-five percent (64.8%) of surveyed residents who expressed an opinion indicated that they were either "very supportive" or "somewhat supportive" of the City of Virginia Beach allocating an additional \$200-\$300 million to address repair, maintenance needs, and expansion opportunities for the Virginia Aquarium.

In terms of ownership and financial responsibility, fifty-four percent (54.3%) of those surveyed, who had an opinion, were either "very supportive" or "somewhat supportive" of a private nonprofit or corporation assuming financial and programming responsibility for the operations of the Virginia Aquarium. However, the level of support decreased when it came to complete ownership transfer, with only forty-one percent (41.4%) indicating they were "very supportive" or "somewhat supportive" of a private nonprofit or corporation taking over both the operations and ownership of the Virginia Aquarium.

Virgina Aquarium Programs and Tourism

The survey results underscore the significant importance of the Virginia Aquarium in Virginia Beach's programs and tourism. Ninety-one percent (91.4%) of the residents surveyed, who had an opinion, either "strongly agree" or "agree" that Virgina Aquarium's stranding response program for sick and injured animals is important.

Similarly, ninety percent (90.4%) of the residents surveyed, who had an opinion, either "strongly agree" or "agree" that Virgina Aquarium provides important educational programs and eighty-four percent (84.1%) of the residents surveyed, who had an opinion, either "strongly agree" or "agree" that Virgina Aquarium is an important tourism driver for the City of Virgina Beach.

Additional Findings


- A significant ninety-four percent (93.9%) of the respondents surveyed have visited the Virginia Aquarium since its opening, demonstrating a strong history of engagement.
- Within the past year, Forty-three percent (42.6%) of respondents have made at least one visit to the Virginia Aquarium, indicating ongoing interest.
- In contrast, only ten percent (9.5%) of those surveyed are currently members of the Virginia Aquarium.
- Streets & roads, stormwater/flooding, school buildings and Virgina Aquarium infrastructure are the infrastructure projects that should be the top priority for improvement according to respondents.







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

Q4. In the past year, how often did you or a member of your household visit the Virginia Aquarium?



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
Q5. Are you a member of the Virginia Aquarium?

by percentage of respondents




Q6. If you had \$100, how would you spend it across the infrastructure projects below?

by percentage of respondents




Q7. Demographics: About how long have you lived in Virginia Beach?


Q8. Demographics: What is the highest level of education you have completed?

Q9. Demographics: Would you say your total annual household income is...





Q11. Demographics: Which of the following best describes your race/ethnicity?



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
Q12. Demographics: What is your age?

Q13. Demographics: How many people in your household are under the age of 18?


