## WARNINGS TO RESPONDENT:

Distinguishing Cobires.

Relationship to Politioner/Platining trus bond

Pursuant to Code of Virginia § 18,2-308, 1:4. Respondent shall not purchase or transport any firearm while this order is in effect. If Respondent has a conceated handgun permit, Respondent must immediately surrender that permit to the court issuing this order. If Respondent violates the conditions of this order, Respondent may be sentenced to juit and/or ordered to pay a fine.

This order will be entered into the Virginia Criminal Information Network. The Respondent may at any time file a motion with the count requesting a hearing to dissolve or modify this order; however, this order remains in full force and effect unless and until dissolved or modified by the count.

## DEFINITIONS:

"Pamily abuse" means any act involving violence, force, or threat that results in bodily injury or places one in reasonable apprehension of death, sexual assault, bodily injury and that is committed by a person against such person's family or household member. Such act includes, but is not limited to, any forceful detention, stalking, criminal sexual assault in violation of Article 7 (§ 18.2-61 et. seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 18.2, or any criminal offense that results in bodily injury or places one in reasonable apprehension of death, sexual assault, or bodily injury.

"Ramily of household member" means (i) the person's spouse, whether or not he or she resides in the same home with the person, (ii) the person's former spouse, whether or not he or she resides in the same home with the person, (iii) the person's parents, stepparents, children, stepphildren, brothers, sisters, half-brothers, half-sisters, grandparents and grandchildren regardless of whether such persons reside in the same home with the person, (iv) the person's mother-in-law, father-in-law, sons-in-law, daughters-in-law, brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law who reside in the same home with the person, or (v) any individual who has a child in common with the defendant, whether or not the person and that individual lave been married or have resided together at any time, or (vi) any individual who cohabits or who, within the previous twelve (12) means, cohabitated with the person, and any children of either of them residing in the same home with the person.

"Physical prevence" includes (i) intentionally maintaining direct visual contact with the petitioner or (ii) unreasonably being within 100 feet from the petitioner's residence or place of employment.
